There is help available at all levels, and a million videos on YouTube. Or you could just talk to one of the enthusiasts at the Robot Workshop.



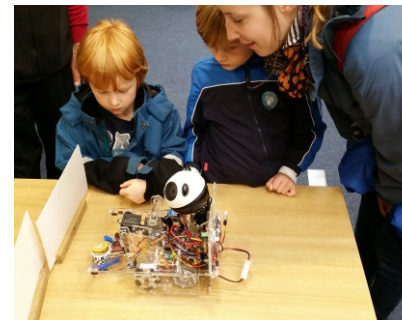
